



Grandma's Undies

If you want to get your students laughing, this is the game for you! It's an effective way for students to practise asking questions, to practise different ways of asking questions and to practise staying focussed. The answer remains the same "Grandma's Undies" (or "Grandma's socks", if "undies are too risqué").

Instructions

The game is highly adaptable. I have my students in a circle, and someone is chosen to be the "answerer". Everyone takes it in turns to ask a question. The aim is for the "Answerer" to answer "Grandma's undies" with a completely straight face. If they smirk, giggle or laugh out loud, or say anything else – like the answer to the actual question - they're out!
